

Installation

#1 – Upload Files

You will receive a zip of files after you purchase tSMS from CodeCanyon. Just upload that ZIP file in root directory of your domain. After upload, extract those files. Your folder structure of the root directory will be something like below

#2 – Visit the domain URL

Visit your website URL. Installation Wizard will be automatically started once you visit your website. Just follow the on screen instructions. You will need to create MySQL Database, Email account for sending emails and last step will be to create a Admin Account. You will also need to verify your purchase as the very step of the Installation Wizard.

#2.1 Instructions



tSMS Installer

This installer will guide you through various installation process and will need you to create Database & Email account from your control panel. It will ask for various details which you will get from your control panel after creating Database and email account. 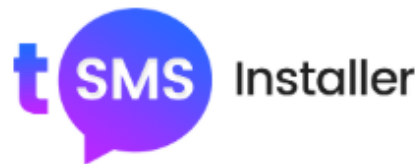
#2.3 Website Details

You will need to enter following details about your Website

Website Name – This will be used in the Title Bar and on your emails which will be sent by the Application.

Website URL – This will also be used in your emails to connect your users with the website.

SMS Gateway API Key – This is an important parameter which will be used for authentication of the SMS Gateway API Call.

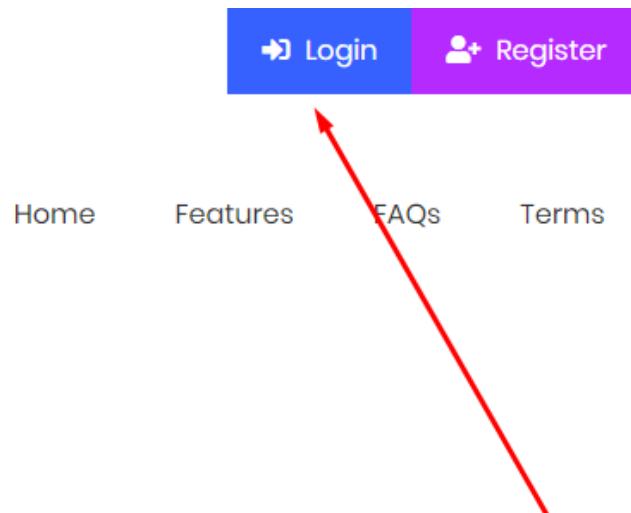

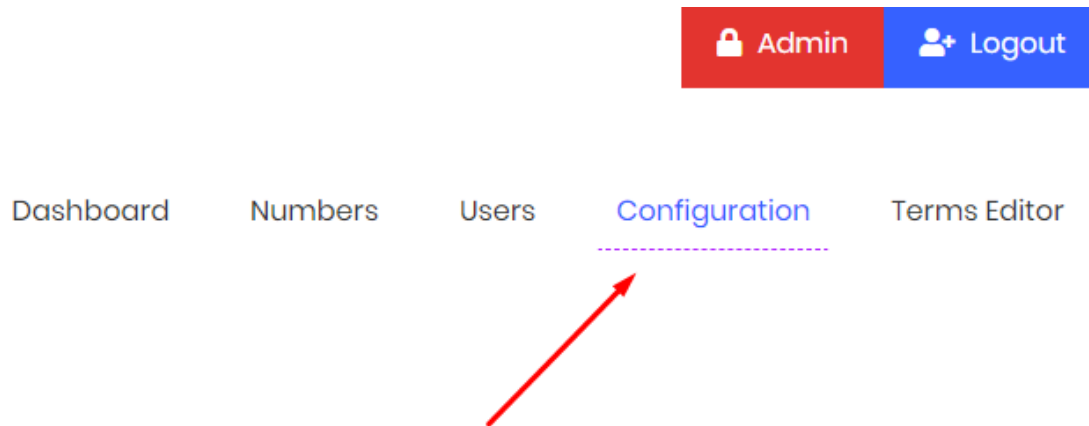

Add your First Number

Finally, it's time to add your very First Number. You can use **Numbers** Page to add a new number or manage already added number.

You will see below form once you visit Numbers Page to add New Number.

First field is to add Phone Number. Add your phone number which you bought from SMS Gateway with the country code and without any space, plus sign or hyphen. For example, if your purchased phone number is **+1 987 654 3210** then enter **19866543210**

Select Country from the second field and then choose which type you want. If you choose "Registered Only", then only registered users of your website will be able to use that number for receiving SMS online. If you choose "Open" then anyone visiting your website will be able to use that number for receiving SMS online.

Setup number on SMS Gateway

You will need to setup a API call everytime your phone number receives a SMS. Most of the SMS Gateways offers this. Below are the settings on which you will need to setup the API call.

URL – <https://yourdomain/api/receive>

Method – GET or POST

Parameters	Details
number	Actual phone number on which message is received.
sender	Sender of the SMS
msg	Actual content of the SMS
msg_id	SMS Message ID
key	The API Key, which you can find in Admin -> Configuration
